

Appointment of Individual Disciples to the District Leaders Conference and Other Governance Positions

Introduction

Many districts have been experiencing lack of couple members to be appointed to DLC positions resulting in some ministries not able to provide the needed pastoral services to the district. Recent consultations also showed that in some districts, couple disciples are not sufficient to fill up even DCS positions.

Further, in developing leaders for the community, it is evident that there are untapped individual members who can be empowered to head ministries, programs, committees or even apostolates.

Policy and Guidelines

A. District Leaders Conference

As an exception to the general policy on pastoral and apostolic service, the Council of Servant Leaders has approved the following policy and guidelines to address the need of the present situation and to ensure that all ministries have the required human resources and capabilities:

1. Following Covenanted individual members, who must be active, can be appointed to the District Leaders Conference (DLC):
 - a) Solo Parents
 - b) Singles
 - c) Widows and Widowers
 - d) Married without their spouses
2. Only ministries which do not require the presence of a couple can be headed by individual members. Refer to Annex A. When applicable, two individuals may co-head a ministry.
3. Committed members, couples or individuals, who are active and determined to have a deep sense of commitment to serve the community, can also be appointed to the DLC. Committed members shall have completed CMP 2.
4. The DCS in consultation with the CS shall determine the suitability of the appointee to the position being considered.

5. The DCS and CS shall ensure that the appointees possess the “common criteria for responsible pastoral and apostolic service,” (CoC, Section 2.7), as follows:
 - a) Faithful attendance at Community Worship and fruitful presence at the Word Sharing Circles;
 - b) Knowledge and observance of the Word of God and Church teachings;
 - c) Adherence to and exemplification of Community Values and Norms;
 - d) Active personal prayer life;
 - e) Openness to feed-back and critique; and
 - f) Good life witnessing.

B. Appointed (but not emerged) DCS

Under an exceptional and meritorious situation during the Emergence Process where the District has insufficient nominees for DCS, the CSL may consider the appointment of the following in order to complete the DCS needed for the District:

1. Active covenanted individual members, upon recommendation of the DCS and endorsement of the CS. They shall determine the suitability of the appointee to the position being considered.
2. Committed members, couples or individuals, who are active and determined to have a deep sense of commitment to serve the community. Committed members shall have completed CMP 2.
3. The appointees must possess the “common criteria for responsible pastoral and apostolic service,” (CoC, Section 2.7), per above.

Effectivity and Amendment

This policy shall be effective immediately. Thereafter, a periodic review on its effectiveness shall be conducted. Any amendments are subject to approval by the CSL.



Clarification on District Leaders' Conference (DLC) Policy

General Provision

The BLD District Leaders' Conference (DLC) is composed of all Ministry Coordinators, Homestead Shepherds and DIP/ Outreach Shepherds. They shall head the ministries and homesteads in all BLD Districts. They are appointed by the District Council of Stewards in consultation with the Cluster Shepherds, in accordance with established criteria. They shall serve until the end of the term of the incumbent DCS and may be re-appointed.

Ministry Coordinators and Homestead Shepherds shall be covenanted members, with the exception approved by the Council of Servant Leaders per CB 06-2021-022A.

- ECSL Circular No. 6-2016-043P (superseding existing provision on appointment of DLC)
- BLD Statutes, May 2009, Section 6.3 (as revised by CB 6-2016-43P)
- BLD Policy, Section 9.5 (as revised by CB 6-2016-043P)
- CSL Circular No. 6-2021-022A (exception to policy – appointment of individuals, etc.)

Criteria of DLC Members

The DCS and CS shall ensure that the appointees possess the “common criteria for responsible pastoral and apostolic service,” (CoC, Section 2.7), as follows:

- a) Faithful attendance at Community Worship and fruitful presence at the Word Sharing Circles;
- b) Knowledge and observance of the Word of God and Church teachings;
- c) Adherence to and exemplification of Community Values and Norms;
- d) Active personal prayer life;
- e) Openness to feed-back and critique; and
- f) Good life witnessing.
