We are called not to judge who deserves mercy; instead, we are to recognize the dignity of every person, especially those who suffer. In doing this, we are destined to inherit God’s kingdom: **“Blessed is he who keeps faith forever, secures justice for the oppressed, gives food to the hungry.”** (Ps 146:7). [CSL Reflection]
